Financial Aid:

All students can apply for Federal Financial Aid. To begin the process, you must first complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). We recommend that you [complete the FAFSA online](#) to have your application processed more quickly. CMC's financial aid code is 004506 for the FAFSA application, and the priority deadline for financial aid is March 31.

Payment Plan:

[Payment plans](#) are also available to students. Nelnet is an interest-free payment plan that breaks up the per-semester cost of tuition into manageable monthly payments, allowing you to spread the cost over five or six months.
